**Access to Environmental Justice** Sep 10 2020 Although it is commonly asserted that enhanced citizen participation results in better environmental policy and improved enforcement of environmental

standards, this hypothesis has rarely been subject to testing on a comparative basis. The contributors to this book set out to study the extent to which citizens can and do exert influence over their urban environments through the legal (and extra-legal) 'gateways' in eleven countries spanning several continents as well as different climates, levels and type of economic development, and national legal and constitutional systems, as well as exhibiting a different set of environmental problems. One interviewee questioned about access to environmental justice, dryly remarked that in his city there was no environment, no justice and no access to either. **Access to Justice in Magistrates' Courts** Oct 24 2021 This book examines access to justice in summary criminal proceedings by considering the ability of defendants to play an active and effective role in the process. 'Access to justice' refers not just to the availability of legally aided representation, but also to the ability of defendants to understand and effectively participate in summary criminal proceedings

more generally. It remains a vital principle of justice that justice should not only be done, but should also be seen to be done by all participants in the process.
